Persistent cookies allow us to recognize you as a unique visitor each time you return. Persistent cookies are stored on your browser cache or mobile device until you choose to delete them.

Analytical/performance cookiesallow us to recognize and count the number of website visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it to help us to improve the way our website works.
